

# “Underwater Acoustics”

## *Invitation*

*to the 25th DEGA Workshop “Physical Acoustics,” jointly organized by the Technical Committee “Physical Acoustics” of the German Acoustical Society (DEGA) and by the Working Group “Acoustics” of the German Physical Society (DPG),*

on October 17 and 18, 2019, at the Physikzentrum Bad Honnef ([www.pbh.de](http://www.pbh.de))

This year’s workshop will deal with the general topic of “Underwater Acoustics.” Various aspects such as underwater noise simulations, signal analysis, experimental investigations, pile driving noise, active control of a ship’s acoustic signature, or underwater communication will be discussed. The scientific program is organized by Jan Abshagen and Anton Homm (both with the Bundeswehr Technical Center for Ships and Naval Weapons, Maritime Technology and Research (WTD 71)), assisted by Stephan Lippert (Hamburg University of Technology) und Frank-Hendrik Wurm (University of Rostock). For this year’s workshop we invited speakers from various countries. Therefore, the official workshop language will be English and **all presentations will be given in English.**

There is **no registration fee** for the workshop. For a limited number of participants **accommodation** at the Physikzentrum is available. Accommodation costs are approximately **200 Euros including all meals** from dinner on Wednesday (October 16) to lunch on Friday (October 18). For nights and meals that are not booked (see registration form) the costs are reduced accordingly.
